Examity – Scheduling Your MQE and Practice Quiz

All MQE Candidates must write their course exams with Examity. In order to write the MQE using Examity, Candidates must first set up a profile in Examity (if they have not already done so for course exams) and schedule their exam. Candidates must set up a profile and schedule their MQE by **August 28**, **2020**.

MQE Candidates also have the option of taking a 30-minute practice quiz, which will test Candidates on content in CBV Institute's MQE Examination Rules, the Examity User Guide, and the Examity Exam Day Instructions. The practice quiz will give Candidates the opportunity to practice connecting to an Examity proctor, opening the practice quiz documents, and uploading their response file. Candidates have until **Friday, September 18** to take the practice quiz, and Candidates must schedule the practice quiz at least 24 hours in advance (i.e., by Thursday September 17).

Examity is now available for MQE Candidates to set up a profile and to schedule their MQE and practice quiz. For instructions on how to do so, Candidates should refer to the "Examity - User Guide - 2020 MQE" document posted on the MQE Moodle page.

FRENCH-SPEAKING PRACTICE INSPECTOR REQUIRED

The Institute is seeking a qualifying CBV to conduct practice inspections in French. This is a paid position. The minimum requirements include:

- A minimum of five (5) years of diversified post-qualification practice experience;
- Fluent in French and English;
- No longer practicing (for example, but not limited to, a recently retired CBV, or a CBV in industry);
- Available immediately, and for a minimum of 100 hours during 2020.

The new French Inspector will conduct practice inspections in French as well as English, as needed, and will work closely and under the direction of the Director, Professional Practice, as well as with the Practice Inspection Committee of the Board. The duties of an Inspector are outlined in the Institute's Mandatory Practice Inspection Policy.
