



TOP CBV UNDER 40 IN MEMORY OF DAVID CORNFIELD, CA, CBV POLICY

THAT the CBV Institute Top CBV Under 40 Award is intended to recognize younger CBVs who have demonstrated success in a broad diversity of interests. Those successes will likely be in a combination of professional and personal life endeavours.

The Top CBV under 40 Award will be granted each year to a deserving CBV. This Award will consist of a recognition plaque and \$750.

AWARD CRITERIA

The award is open to all Members in good standing who are 39 years old or younger as at December 31st and have not previously been recipients of the award.

Nominators must be a CBV, and must demonstrate that the nominee has brought distinction to the profession and/or given outstanding service in one or more of the following areas:

1. **Career Accomplishments**

- a. Excellence in Business Valuations, career position, other professional/ academic achievements, etc.

2. **CBV Profession – Service and Contributions**

- a. Involvement with CBV Institute and regional/national CBV Institute events.
- b. Involvement with other professional bodies or business-related organization, and
- c. Promotion of the profession, e.g., communications (speaking, writing, media), recruitment of students.

3. **Education**

- a. Contribution to CBV Institute education, e.g., teaching, mentoring, and coaching.

4. **Community / Charity Service**

- a. Charitable community work other business groups.

5. **Other**

- a. An open category to include personal interest activities, e.g., sports and arts.

Successful nominees will likely display the highest level of leadership/achievement in more than one category while demonstrating a notable level of success in several others. Importantly, candidates should clearly be known as Chartered Business Valuators in making the achievements cited in their nomination. Nominees will exhibit characteristics of innovation, creativity, leadership, impact, and positive attitude.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Nominees will be judged on the following criteria:

1. Impact of the accomplishment on his or her career, and
2. Impact of volunteerism on his or her community.

JUDGING COMMITTEE

The Awards Committee will judge nominations for the CBV Institute Top CBV Under 40 Award, and make a recommendation for approval by the Board of Directors. Members of the CBV Institute Awards Committee are not eligible to be nominated.

NOMINATING PROCEDURES

Any Member may nominate another Member by providing the following information:

1. Completed nomination form, and
2. A one to two-page signed letter containing supporting reasons why the nominee satisfies the award criteria.

All nominations must be sent to the attention of the President & CEO of CBV Institute by **December 31st of each year.**
