



ACADEMIC HONESTY POLICY

THAT all Registered Students and MQE Candidates have an obligation to maintain the highest standards of academic honesty.

Academic honesty requires that persons do not cheat by attempting to gain an improper advantage in an academic evaluation. Forms of cheating include, but are not limited to:

1. Obtaining a copy of an examination before it is officially available or learning of an examination question before it is officially available;
2. Copying another person's answer to an examination question;
3. Consulting an unauthorized source during an examination;
4. Obtaining assistance by means of documentary, electronic or other aides that have not been approved for use;
5. Impersonating or having someone impersonate one's self in an examination.

Suspected breaches of academic honesty will be investigated by the Institute and/or its designate, in accordance with the Academic Honesty policy of the Institute, and/or the rules and regulations of the university acting as the Institute's designate.

Sanctions that may be imposed by the Institute include, but are not limited to:

1. A written disciplinary warning or reprimand;
2. Failure of the examination;
3. Notation on transcript;
4. Suspension of affiliation;
5. Termination of affiliation.
